Meet Conditions

1. This competition is a Level 4 licensed meet, held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules.
2. This competition is only open to members of Potters Bar Swimming Club.
3. The promoter is Louise Hughes, on behalf of Potters Bar Swimming Club.
4. This meet is eligible for qualification for the Hertfordshire ASA County Championships.
5. There will be medals awarded for 1ST, 2ND and 3RD placed swimmers in each age group in each event, with recognition awards for all other swimmers. Further awards will be presented to the overall Junior Champions and Club Champions.
6. The age groups for boys and girls are, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and over. The Junior Champion will be the fastest swimmer in the ages of 9-14yrs age group and the Senior Champion will encompass all age groups.
7. For this competition, it will be age at 31st December 2017.
8. Events will be 50s in all strokes, 100s in all strokes, 200 m freestyle, and 100 IM.
9. The pool is 25metres long with 6 lanes and anti-wave lane ropes will be in place.
10. Heats shall be swum as mixed age, with swimmers seeded by entry times, in spearhead order in each heat, by slowest to fastest.
11. Over the top starts may be used at the referee's discretion.
12. In the event of a false start swimmers must perform a safe, shallow entry dive and NOT topple/fall head downwards as this is dangerous.
13. There will be no qualifying times to enter this meet.
14. The closing date for entries will be 1st June 2017; entries are to be sent to the PBSC Open Meet account which is, pbscopenmeets@gmail.com and prior to the closing date.
15. Results will be posted on the Potters Bar website and will also be supplied to British Swimming to be displayed on the national ranking database.
16. Spectator admission will be £1 per person, per session including a programme of events.
17. Entries to this meet will be held on a computer and consent to the holding of personal information as required by the Data Protection Act 1998 will be deemed to have been given by the submission of entry. Personal data will be available for inspection during the meet on application to the promoter.
18. In accordance with the ASA Child Safeguarding Policies and Procedures any parents or carers of swimmers under the age of 18 who wish to take photographic or video images are requested to focus on their own child as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in those images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends through social media platforms.
Should you have any concerns about photography or filming at this event then please bring them to the attention of the Promoter – Louise Hughes
19. All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at the Furzefield Centre. Neither the promoter nor Potters Bar Swimming Club will be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during this meet.
